- 3. <u>Influential Guide</u> ~ Farewell Address (**Josh 23**) to Death of Joshua (**Jdg 2**)
- ✤ 3 roles reflect Joshua's role towards people towards God an obedient servant
 - ♦ Follower of Moses / Leader of People / Guide of Posterity
 - \diamond 'Formal' roles in Israelite society / Aspects of each sprinkled through life
- He transitioned gradually between the roles / He grew into them
- Today we'll examine Joshua as a <u>faithful follower</u>

Followership vs. Leadership

- Ill: Amazon ~ 190k books on leadership / There are only 173 on followership
 - ♦ "Did you know that <u>followership</u> is a word?"
 - Ship" "Suffix appended to a noun to form a new noun denoting property or state of being, time spent in a role, or a specialized union."
 - ♦ But don't be fooled / Many followership books are written for leadership
- ✤ <u>III</u>: Google ~ Leadership ~ 800,000,000 hits / Followership ~ 740,000 hits
- Ratio between leadership and followership is about 1,000 to 1
 - ♦ Phrase "captains of thousands" occurs 17 times in Old Testament
 - A modern captain has 1,000 books to read vs. 1 by his 1,000 troops

Followership Held in Disrepute

- Calling someone "excellent follower" not perceived (or meant) as a compliment
- Until recently few had thought to study or teach on the topic of followership
 - ♦ Decent followers thought to be a natural by-product of good leadership
 - ♦ But recent studies have occurred on the topic of followership
 - \diamond Good followers are expected to reflect the following qualities (11):
 - Honesty, loyalty, brave dissent, competence, good judgment, discretion, humility, good teamsmanship, initiative, responsibility, trustworthiness
- "Do you see what I see?"
 - ♦ This could easily be a list of desirable character traits in leaders

Xition: Good followers are just good leaders viewed from a different perspective

Good Followers Often Make Good Leaders

- It's true, some followers don't want to bear formal responsibility of leadership
 - \diamond They're often fine with informal responsibility, however
- But being described as a good follower should not be perceived as a slight
 - ♦ For every Captain <u>Kirk</u>, there's often a Commander <u>Spock</u>
 - ♦ There's the Lone Ranger and Tonto, Batman and Robin, Moses and Joshua
- An online <u>Air Force</u> study titled, "Dynamic Followership", had following quote:
 - * "A dynamic followership program should produce individuals who, when the moment arrives, seamlessly transition to lead effectively."
- Let's examine Joshua's career as a very successful "follower" of Moses
 - ♦ But first, let's clarify what followers truly follow...
 - * "Followers do not serve leaders. Rather, leaders and followers both serve the common purpose or mission, within a shared set of values."
 - ~ Ira Chaleff in "The Courageous Follower"
 - ♦ We'll highlight 24 desirable character traits exhibited at 10 points in his life

1. Joshua Leads Israelites in War with Amalekites

- Read Ex 17.8-9a ~ "Now Amalek came .. fight with Amalek."

 - ♦ Dependable ~ Moses knows he can rely on him / Reputation preceded him
- Read Ex 17.10 ~ "So Joshua did as Moses .. fought with Amalek."
 - ♦ Obedient ~ Joshua did just as told / Too many commanders don't
- Read Ex 17.13 ~ "So Joshua defeated .. edge of the sword."
 - ♦ Steadfast ~ Joshua pursued the matter to a conclusion / Too many don't
- Read Ex 17.14 ~ "Then the Lord .. from under heaven."
 - ♦ Invested ~ God honors Joshua with promise / Perhaps wanted to pursue

2. Moses Ascends Mt Sinai with Joshua

- Read Ex 24.9-18 ~ "Then Moses went up .. forty days and forty nights"
 - v14 ~ Joshua was with Moses when he left the elders
 - ♦ Useful ~ Of all people Moses wanted Joshua with him
 - v18 ~ But Moses went into the cloud atop it alone
 - Disciplined ~ Joshua waited patiently alone for 40 days

Xition: Moses (and Joshua) descend My Sinai – 3rd vignette

3. Moses **Descends** Mt Sinai and Rejoins Joshua

- Read Ex 32.7-8, 15-18 ~ "And the Lord .. singing I hear."
 - ♦ v7-8 ~ God informs Moses of what's happened below
 - v17 ~ Joshua doesn't know about people's idolatry
 - Optimistic ~ Joshua assumes best of people

4. Joshua Serves Around the Clock in Tabernacle

- Read Ex 33.7-11 ~ "Moses took his .. from the tabernacle."
 - ♦ v11 ~ Moses comes & goes from tabernacle Joshua remains
 - Reliable ~ Joshua remains at tabernacle around the clock
 - Sacrificial ~ Joshua lives solitary existence apart from family & friends

5. Joshua Protests 2 Elders Prophesying

- Read Num 11.24-29 ~ "So Moses went .. elders of Israel."
 - v28 ~ Joshua can't contain himself
 - Respectful ~ Joshua calls Moses his lord
 - ♦ Loyal ~ Joshua eager to protect Moses' role and reputation
 - Bold ~ Joshua willing to advise Moses

6. Joshua Selected as a Spy

- Read Num 13.1-4a, 8, 16 ~ "And the Lord .. son of Nun, Joshua."
 - $\diamond~\mathbf{v2}~$ Joshua selected to represent Ephraim
 - ♦ Leader ~ Joshua selected / referred to as leader in v2
 - Solution Discrete ~ A spy must be able to guard his tongue
 - ♦ Wise ~ A spy must be able to think quickly

Xition: Joshua and Caleb argue for invasion – 7th vignette

7. Joshua and Caleb Argue for Invasion

- Read Num 13.25 ~ "And they returned .. after forty days."
 - v27 ~ Report starts out good / "flows with milk and honey"
 - ♦ v30 ~ But Caleb had to quiet the people / "Let us go up"
 - ♦ v32 ~ Other spies give "bad report of the land"
 - Num 14.4 ~ Some start an insurrection "Let us select a leader"
 - v5 ~ "Moses and Aaron fall on their faces"
 - Humble ~ v6 ~ Joshua & Caleb "tore clothes"
 - ♦ Assertive ~ v7 ~ Joshua wasn't afraid to speak up in time of turmoil
 - Truthful ~ v7 ~ "exceedingly good land" / Not changing story for fear
 - Q: <u>Samuel Goldwyn</u> ~ "I want everyone to tell me the truth, even if it costs them their jobs."
 - Courageous ~ v9-10 ~ Encouraged invasion despite fear and panic

8. Joshua Commissioned as Leader

- Read Num 27.15-21 ~ "Then Moses spoke .. all the congregation."
 - Saved ~ v18 ~ Within the Church there must be evidence of God's grace
 - Authoritative ~ v20 ~ Formal authority tends towards greater obedience
- 9. Joshua & Eleazar to Ensure Eastern Tribes Honor Commitment
 - Read Num 32.28-30 ~ "So Moses gave .. land of Canaan."
 - Honorable ~ v29 ~ Moses giving a command beyond his own life
- 10. Joshua & Eleazar to Oversee Division of Land
 - Read Num 34.16-18 ~ "And the Lord .. for the inheritance"
 - Fair ~ v17 ~ God establishes equitable process / Eleazar and Joshua key
 - **J** Joshua spent 40 years as a 'faithful follower' of Moses
 - **The best followers are merely leaders in training**
 - **D** Next time we'll look at Joshua as the leader of Israel
