Melchizedek in the Bible

- Name is used only twice in Old Testament
 - o **Gen 14** (3 verses) and **Psalm 110** (1 verse)
- Name used 9 times in New Testament
 - Hebrews 5 thru 7 (44 verses)
- 2 mentions in 4 verses expands to 9 mentions in 44 verses
 - Are types of the Old Testament important in the New? YES
 - Moses didn't enter the Promised Land because he struck the rock
 - God judged Moses for unbelief (Num 20) ~ not disobedience
 - 1 Cor 10.4 says the Rock was Christ
 - Moses should have <u>asked</u> of the Rock but he <u>demanded</u> of it

Hebrews 7 ~ Commentary of Melchizedek

- Read Heb 11.1-3
- Verse 3 says "without father, mother or genealogy"
 - "Does this mean Melchizedek was supernatural?" ~ NO
 - The writer of Hebrews is emphasizing what the Bible does <u>not</u> say
 - Mzk came out of nowhere ~ no mom, no dad, no end . . .
 - But note that Melchizedek was <u>made like</u> the Son of God
 - 2,000 years before Christ ~ but like Him ~ prefiguring Him
- Melchizedek is thought to have been King of JeruSALEM
 - He's the first priest mentioned in the Bible
 - o His name means <u>righteousness</u> and salem means <u>peace</u>

Melchizedek served communion

- He served Abraham communion ~ bread and wine
- And Abraham tithed a tenth of the increase to him.
- This foreshadowed the Mosaic law, ceremonial meals, Levitical priesthood

Jesus is our perfect High Priest ~ in the order of Melchizedek He has no beginning and no end ~ His reign will never cease And He will minister bread and wine to us forever
