## Communion Meditation – Jesus in Genesis

Genesis 15.1-6 Jesus and Heavenly Heritage June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2010

## Gen 15.6 is is a famous Bible verse

- "Abram believed in the Lord, and He accounted it to him for righteousness"
  - Abel's gift was respected by God in Gen 4.4 (salvation?)
  - o But here we see righteousness imputed to Abram because of faith
  - o This indicates that a true atonement for sin would one day come
  - But that's Abram's faith ~ Our type is found in God's promise

## "What was it that Abram believed?

- That God would bless him with descendants
  - o In **Gen 13.16** God promised descendants would be like "dust of earth"
  - Here in v5 He says they would be like the "stars in the sky"
  - Earthly descendants already promised ~ Now the heavenly are
    - <u>Dust represents physical</u> descendants
    - Stars represent <u>heavenly</u> desendants

## **Earthly and Heavenly Heritages**

- Abram had no earthly future no son to receive his inheritance
- People of the earth had no spiritual future –no path to an eternal inheritance
- As God gave Abram an <u>earthly</u> heritage in <u>Isaac</u>
- He gave all mankind a heavenly heritage, through Abram, in Christ
- <u>Isaac</u> was the son of promise for Abram's <u>earthly</u> prodigy
- <u>Jesus</u> was the Son of promise for Abram's <u>heavenly</u> prodigy
- In Abram we see <u>both</u> realities fulfilled: <u>earthly</u> and <u>heavenly</u>

Faith is still the instrument by which God grants us righteousness
Heb 11.6 ~ "Without faith it is impossible to please Him."
Rom 10.17 ~ "Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God"
In coming to the Table we exercise our faith to hear our God
