Communion Meditation – Jesus in Genesis

Genesis 21.1-12 Jesus and Isaac July 4th, 2010

v2 "Sarah conceived and bore Abraham a son"

- Sarah was not just old . . . Sarah was too old to bear children
- **Gen 18.11** says "Sarah had passed the age of childbearing"
 - lit. "the manner of women had ceased to be with Sarah"
- **Gen 17.17** shows that Sarah was 90 years old
 - That Sarah had a child was <u>not amazing</u> ~ it was <u>miraculous</u>

1 of 7 Similarities between Isaac and Jesus

- 1. Miracle birth foretold ~ **Gen 15.4** "one who will come from your own body"
 - o Is 7.14 ~ "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son"
- 2. Long time between the promise and the fulfillment (**Gen 12.4** ~ 25 years)
 - From Isaiah to birth of Jesus is nearly 600 years
- 3. Both women disbelieved then evidenced faith (Sarah laughed but then . . .)
 - Heb 11.11 says Sarah "received strength to conceive"
 - Mary said "How can this be?" but then said "Let it be to me . . ."
- 4. Both babies were named before birth (Gen 17.19 and Luke 1.31)
- 5. Both babies born when God chose . . .
 - o **Gen 21.2** ~ "at the set time of which God had spoken"
 - o Gal 4.4 ~ "when the fullness of the time"
- 6. Both sons were a joy to their father (Gen 22.2 and Mat 3.17)
- 7. In Chapter 22 we'll get into their similarities c/sacrifice

Isaac is a Type of Jesus ~ What does that mean?

- These types were evidence of Christ buried in the OT
- They were appealed to by Christ as proof that the OT taught of Him
- We can do the same ~ Point at Christ over 6,000 years
 - o from Adam to Abraham, Abraham to Jesus, Jesus to today

God's Word Changed Sarah ~ She <u>laughed</u> - But then she <u>believed</u>
God's Word Changes us too ~ First we <u>scoff</u> - then we <u>reflect</u> - then we <u>accept</u>
As we learn God's Word we pray for <u>faith to believe</u> and <u>courage to obey</u>
