Genesis 22.15-19 Faith Rewarded August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010

#### v1-14 ~ Review

- 1. God tested Abraham's faith by commanding him to sacrifice Isaac
- 2. Abraham passed the test with flying colors
- 3. And now he is promised the reward for his success

### v15-16 ~ "Angel of the LORD"

- We are fairly certain this is Jesus ~ theophany (pre-incarnate appearance)
  - o In **v12** the Angel referred to Himself as God "not withheld . .. from Me"

## v17 ~ "stars and sand"

- Both <u>spiritual</u> and <u>physical</u> descendants promised
- "Your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies"
  - Victory in this world and the next is promised

### v18a ~ "In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed"

- We are clearly told in the New Testament that this refers to Jesus
  - Rom 9.7, Gal 3.16 and Heb 11.18

# v18b ~ "because you have obeyed My voice"

- Abraham's obedience blessed the entire world
- <u>Sinfulness</u> leads to <u>selfishness</u>, selfishness leads to <u>meaninglessness</u>
- <u>III</u>: Josiah visited co-workers house ~ meaninglessness palpable
- The rewards for obedience expand way beyond ourselves
- Who does your obedience bless?
  - yourself (of course) ~ family, friends, neighbors

Can your obedience bless the entire world? ~ Collectively, yes . . .

We are the salt and light of the world . . .

Our obedience to God blesses the world

Our disobedience diminishes it

Obedience begins at this table . . . Will you serve God? Will you obey? If you do so, you will be blessed – and you will be a blessing to the world
