Sermon Series Review

- Series started with message "Know Your Enemy"
 - ♦ Satan and his demons hate humans and heavily influence world systems
 - ♦ Our own <u>hearts</u> serve as <u>outposts</u> in their attacks on us (*if we let them*)
- Last week's topic was "Master Your Weaponry"
 - ♦ We wear <u>armor</u> for <u>defense</u> to <u>protect</u> us from <u>temptation</u> and attack
 - ♦ We use the <u>sword</u>, <u>prayer</u>, and <u>fasting</u> to <u>oppose</u> and <u>defeat</u> our enemies
- Today is "Engage Your Allies" / Today we realize we're not alone in this war
- Next week we'll merge the 3 topics into "Embrace Your Battle"

"Allies" Correlates & Contrasts With "Enemies"

- This message is a <u>counterpoint</u> to the one on <u>enemies</u>
 - ♦ Illustration on handout should look familiar
- Our enemies are "the world, the flesh, the devil" & his <u>henchmen</u>
 - ♦ "What evil <u>villain</u> is complete without <u>henchmen</u>?"
 - ♦ <u>III</u>: <u>Despicable Me</u> Gru has his <u>minions</u> to do his bidding
 - ♦ <u>Henchmen</u> are always <u>buffoons</u> in <u>comedy</u> films / but now in <u>action</u> too
 - ♦ But <u>loyal service</u> of <u>henchmen</u> make the <u>villain</u> who he is
- In a comparable way the <u>allies</u> of a <u>hero</u> make him who he is

"Who are our Allies?"

- Our allies are <u>God</u>, His <u>angels</u>, & the <u>Church</u> "Where are they deployed?"
 - ♦ Allies are of less help when far in the rear / 1) heaven, 2) earth, 3) heart
- Enemies were 1) Satan, 2) demons, 3) world systems, 4) our flesh
- Allies are 1) God in heaven, 2) angels, 3) Church, and 4) God in heart
 - ♦ Read Eph 3.1-21 ~ Please read along with someone with handout

Xition: First, let's speak of our allies in heaven ...

Engage Your Allies

1. Heaven

God in Heaven – (Father and Son)

- Throne of God is in heaven and God rules all creation from there
 - Ps 103.19 ~ "The LORD has established His throne in heaven, and His kingdom rules over all."
- ◆ 1st ~ in heaven we have the <u>Father</u> (16 highlights)
 - ♦ When we read <u>God</u>, the <u>Trinity</u>, <u>or</u> the <u>Father alone</u>, may be in mind
 - All 5 possessive occurrences of "His" in our text refers to the Father
 - v5 ~ "<u>His</u> holy apostles and prophets"
 - v6 ~ "<u>His</u> promise in Christ"
 - v7 ~ "the effective working of <u>His</u> power"
 - v16 ~ "the riches of <u>His</u> glory"
 - v16 ~ "<u>His</u> Spirit"
 - ♦ God the Father chooses <u>what</u> to do and <u>when</u>
 - v3 ~ "by revelation <u>He made known</u>" / God chooses "what" to reveal "when"
 - v9 ~ "mystery .. <u>hidden</u> in God"
 - v10 ~ "manifold wisdom of God" / "multi-colored"
 - v11 ~ "eternal purpose which He accomplished"
 - v15 ~ "Father .. from whom whole family in heaven and earth is named"
 - v20 ~ "able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think"
- 2nd ~ <u>Christ the Son</u> is in heaven as well (9 highlights of Jesus)
 - ♦ Jesus is <u>woven</u> throughout our text
 - ♦ We know Jesus ascended to heaven after His resurrection
 - Read Acts 2.32-33 ~ "This Jesus God has raised .. you now see and hear."
 - ♦ We are said to be "with Christ" we are <u>seated</u> in the heavenlies with Him
 - v11 ~ "in Christ Jesus our Lord .. we have boldness and access"

Xition: Thirdly – in heaven we have the angels . . .

3rd ~ Angels

- Angels fill heaven their rear base is heaven
 - ♦ Jacob's ladder (Gen 28) had angels coming and going between heaven and earth
 - ♦ Jesus usually referred to angels with phrase, "angels in heaven"
- Jesus said He could summon more than <u>12 legions</u> (1,000's) of angels (Mat 26)
- Angels are strong / Read Ps 103.20 ~ "Bless the Lord, you .. of His word."
 - ♦ Given tremendous power of angels it's odd they're so seldom requested
 - Ps 35.4-5 ~ "Let those be put to shame .. angel of the LORD chase them"
- "Are we to request or call upon angels?"
 - ♦ David prayed to God to employ angels on his behalf
 - Ps 35.4-5 ~ "Let those be put to shame .. angel of the LORD chase them"

4th ~ The Church Triumphant

- ✤ We have a 4th ally in heaven
 - In Revelation 6.9-11 we read of martyrs "When he opened .. was completed"
 - ♦ These martyrs in heaven cry out to God for justice prayers (*Esau's blood*)
- The transfiguration of Christ appears in all 3 synoptic gospels (Mt 17, Mk 9, Lk 9)
 - ♦ All 3 say it was <u>Moses</u> and <u>Elijah</u> that consulted with Jesus
 - ♦ Luke shares content: "spoke of His death which He was about to accomplish"
- "What was the purpose of the transfiguration?"
 - ♦ It's not clear / but appears members of the Church Triumphant <u>counseled</u> Jesus
 - "Isn't this remarkable?" / That Jesus would consult with them
 - ♦ Jesus did not entrust Himself with any man on earth Yet these he trusted
- We pray only to God / We're <u>not</u> to pray to men or angels
 - ♦ Yet men and angels in heaven are aware of what's happening here
 - Peter says (1 Pet 1.12) ~ "things which angels desire to look into"

2. Earth

The Church Militant

- Ephesians 3 is primarily about the Church the mystery of the gospel
 - ♦ Gentiles are joining Jews fully (v6) "fellow heirs of the same body"
- The Church <u>informs the angels</u> of the mystery of the gospel
 - Read v10 ~ "that now the manifold wisdom .. heavenly places"
- The Church is to glorify God in heaven "to all generations" (v21)
- The Church is <u>Christ's body</u> on earth
 - Read Eph 1.22-23 ~ "And He put all .. fills all in all."
 - ✤ Ephesians 5 presents human marriage as analogous to Christ and Church
 - Jesus "nourishes and cherishes" the Church (v29)
- Paul, writing Timothy, called the Church "the pillar and ground of the truth"
- Too many Christians have a low view of the Church they minimize its role
 - ♦ But the Church is central to all of God's plans
 - The Church is the "bride" of Christ / the "body" of Christ

Angels

- "Angel" means messenger / They do God's commands / Ps 103.20 ~ "Bless the Lord, you His angels, who excel in strength, who do His word, heeding the voice of His word."
- Heb 1.14 ~ "ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation"
- Angels are in only <u>1 verse</u> of our text (v10) yet their <u>role</u> on earth is <u>great</u>
- "How have angels helped people?" / To name a few
 - ♦ Angels announced births of <u>Ishmael</u>, <u>Samson</u>, <u>Samuel</u>, <u>John the Baptist</u>, <u>Jesus</u>
 - ♦ Angels saved Lot and destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah
 - ♦ Angels <u>fed Elijah</u> in the wilderness after he'd fled from Jezebel
 - ♦ Angels executed 185k <u>Assyrian</u> soldiers surrounding Jerusalem (*Hezekiah prayed*)
 - ♦ Angels orchestrated every phase of the Great Tribulation
- Hebrews cautions that we may interact with angels without knowing it (Heb 13.2)

Xition: We now move from earth to within the heart of believers . . .

3. Heart

God in Our Hearts (Son and Spirit)

- Holy Spirit
 - v5 ~ "it has now been <u>revealed</u> by the Spirit"
 - v16 ~ "strengthened with might through <u>His Spirit in the inner man</u>"
 - v20 ~ "according to the power that works in us"
- The Holy Spirit is said to <u>dwell within us</u> / 2 refs here (16, 20)
 - ♦ Paul's famous <u>rhetorical</u> question to the Corinthians
 - Read 1 Cor 6.19-20 ~ ".. do you not know .. which are God's"
 - Then his brief <u>command</u> in **1 Thes 5.19** ~ "Do not quench the Spirit."
- But <u>Christ</u> is also said to dwell <u>within us</u>
 - v17 ~ "that <u>Christ may dwell</u> in your hearts through faith"
 - ♦ Not in addition to the Spirit Holy Spirit is sometimes called Spirit of Christ
 - ♦ We must tread carefully when distinguishing within the Godhead

Contrast of Enemies to Allies

- 1. Satan in heaven contrasts with God the Father, Jesus, & Church triumphant
- 2. <u>Demons</u> contrast with <u>angels</u> (1/3 to 2/3)
- 3. "Old Man" of our <u>flesh</u> contrasts with <u>Holy Spirit</u> and <u>Jesus</u> dwelling within us
 When we "walk in the Spirit" we are victorious
- So far so good / Pairing up in athletics or gymnastics I like our odds
- But what is our last match up...?
- 4. The systems of the world contrasted with the Church militant
 - ♦ Our confidence here probably wanes Today's Church is weak
 - ✤ Too many Christians have abandoned the Church as unworthy of them
 - Many individual churches are truly unworthy of being called Christian
 - ♦ Yet God will never give up on His Church
 - ♦ His plan will prevail / Christ's body will storm the gates of hell


Ephesians 3 New King James Version (NKJV)

3 For this reason **I**, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for you Gentiles— ² if indeed you have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which was given to me for you; ³ how that by revelation He made known to me the mystery (as I have briefly written already, ⁴ by which, when you read, you may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ), ⁵ which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets; ⁶ that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel, ⁷ of which I became a minister according to the gift of the' grace of God given to me by the effective working of His' power.

⁸ To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, ⁹ and to make all see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the / beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who created all things through Jesus Christ; ¹⁰ to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly *places*, ¹¹ according to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord, ¹² in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him: ¹³ Therefore I ask that you do not lose heart at my' tribulations for you, which is your glory!

14 For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁵ from whom the whole family in heaven and / earth is named, ¹⁶ that He would grant you, according to/ (the riches of His glory,) to be strengthened with might' through His Spirit in the inner man, ¹⁷ that Christ may ' dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸ may be able to comprehend with' all the saints what *is* the width and length and depth and height+ ¹⁹ to know the love of Christ which passes' knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

²⁰ Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, ²¹ to Him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.


