Communion Meditation – The Suffering Servant

Isaiah 52.14 Tortured June 19th, 2011

v14 ~ "Just as many were astonished at you, So His <u>visage</u> was marred more than any man, And His <u>form</u> more than the sons of men"

Jesus was not just Executed / He was Tortured

- Arrested in Garden
- Beaten, slapped and taunted by Sanhedrin before the High Priest
- Jesus <u>bound</u> by Sanhedrin and taken to Pilate who had Him <u>flogged</u>
- Soldiers <u>crowned</u> him with thorns and beat Him with their <u>fists</u> and <u>staffs</u>
- Crucifixion ~ Nails through hands and feet / spear in side

Prisoners are sometimes Tortured

- Adoniram Judson ~ missionary to Burma (brutalized for 20 months)
- Reading "Unbroken" about WWII prisoners (Zamperini) being mistreated
- Prisoners are tortured for many reasons
 - 1. <u>Punish</u> them for any infraction of rules
 - 2. Starve them to keep them weak and unable to escape
 - 3. <u>Humiliate</u> them to break their wills to make them easier to control
 - 4. Bully and abuse them for pleasure or revenge

Jesus ~ Divine and Human

- Jesus is God and Man / <u>He knew</u> what was going to happen to Him
 - o As a man He knew the physical suffering that awaited Him
 - As <u>God</u> He knew He would have to endure the torments of <u>hell</u> . . .
- "Was this foreknowledge of suffering a good thing?"
 - \circ $\,$ There is a fear of the $\underline{unknown}\,$ / $\,$ But there is also fear of the $\underline{known}\,$
 - When something is unknown there can be <u>hope</u> (raft, prisons, better place)
 - o <u>III</u>: Louis Zamperini kept hoping his situation would improve
 - "If I had to do it all over again ~ I'd kill myself."

Torture is an attack upon a person's humanity / dehumanize . . . Jesus (the God-man) endured physical torture and hell's torments He knew it was coming / Yet endured it for our sakes
