

## Communion Meditation – Psalm 37

Psalm 37.34

Good Waiters

### Servants are “Waiters”

- **v34a** ~ “Wait on the Lord” ~ “*Doesn’t that make us all waiters?*”
  - Servants are expected to wait ~ And they’re to wait respectfully . . .
  - We say we’re servants of God on the earth . . . But are we good waiters?
- **v34b** ~ “and keep His way”
  - A good waiter “*lives to serve*” ~ “*Your wish is my command!*”
- If you’re a bad waiter then you’re probably a bad servant . . .

### Exalted and Exultant

- **v34c** ~ “He shall exalt you to inherit the land”
  - We that wait upon the Lord shall be rewarded for our service
    - Good service is expected at a restaurant
    - You may generously tip good service ~ but bad service sticks out
- **v34d** ~ “you shall see . . . the wicked cut off”
  - This allows us opportunity to exult . . . We are made to love justice
  - Those who’ve suffered injustice ~ shall see justice prevail . . .

Though we are God’s servants ~ at this table we are served

Just as Jesus served His apostles at the Passover meal ~ He serves us

And we must wait ~ wait to be served by the Lord
