## Jonah is an Unusual Book (7 ways)

- 1. Prophets were typically sent to <u>Judah</u> or <u>Israel</u> | Jonah sent to <u>Assyria</u> (*enemy*)
- 2. Prophets usually <u>obeyed</u> | Jonah <u>disobeyed</u> by running away
- 3. Book is not series of prophetic utterances | it is a biographical narrative
- 4. Book contains only one 8-word prophecy | and it does not come to pass
- 5. Prophets plead for <u>repentance</u> | Jonah doesn't and is <u>displeased to see it</u>
- 6. Jonah has a disregard for life | pagans of the story respect life
- 7. Jonah misbehaves throughout | pagans turn to God in fear & repentance

## Assyria (capital Nineveh) was a Superpower of that Day (Wicked)

- The story of Jonah occurs around 760 BC during reign of Jeroboam II
- During his reign (2 Kings 14.23-27) both Israel and Judah regained strength
- Assyria had weakened over past 50 yrs but would soon rise
- Assyria was cruel to conquered foes ~ Assurnarsipal (c.875 B.C.E.)
  - o "I built a pillar over against his gate, and I flayed all the chief men ... and I covered the pillar with their skins ... some I impaled upon the pillar on stakes. Many captives ... I burned with fire ... From some I cut off their hands and their fingers, and from others I cut off their noses, their ears ... of many I put out the eyes."
- Israel would fall to Assyria within 40 years of this incident

## Jonah Flees from God

- The wickedness of Nineveh is personified as appearing before God
- God commands Jonah to go there and cry out against it
  - Nineveh is about 500 miles from him to the <u>northeast</u>
  - Jonah instead runs off to Joppa in the <u>southwest</u> (~60 miles)
  - He books passage to Tarshish (1k or 2k miles away Italy or Spain)
- Jonah flees from "the presence of the Lord"
- We don't know why Jonah flees ~ Perhaps he believes God will let him go

Jonah lived during the final years of the Israelite nation

He was a prophet of God ~ but he was far from perfect

Yet God had a use for him ~ and would not let him get out of his assigned duty

God sends Jonah (prophet of the northern kingdom) to Nineveh (pagan city)
