Jonah 2 (read 1.17 through 2.10)

"God Delivers Jonah"

June 2nd, 2013

Recap

God commanded Jonah to go to Nineveh
 Instead Jonah tried to run away
 God sent a supernatural storm
 Only God knew that Jonah would not die
 About 500 miles to the northeast
 At least 1,000 miles to the west
 Sailors throw Jonah into the sea
 God preserved Jonah via the fish

v17b ~ "Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights"

- God had <u>preserved</u> Jonah's life / But He had <u>not yet saved</u> him
- Salvation <u>did</u> come ~ but only after a horrific <u>three day ordeal</u>
- III: Bible story depictions ~ Noah's ark & Jonah in family room with light & Bible

Jonah Recognized the Peril He Was In

- v2 ~ "affliction", "out of the belly of Sheol"
- v3 ~ "into the deep", "floods surrounded me"
- v5 ~ "waters surrounded me", "deep closed around me"
- v6 ~ "earth .. closed behind me forever", "from the pit"
- He had not yet been "saved" / He was not yet "safe"

Jonah Acknowledged Only God Could Save Him

- v1 ~ "Then Jonah prayed .. from the fish's belly"
- Jonah humbly prayed / but only after 3 days . . .
 - o He had to have been incredibly uncomfortable
 - o v5 ~ "Weeds were wrapped around my head"
 - o **v6** ~ "went down to the moorings of the mountains"
 - o How did he endure pressure? .. get enough oxygen? .. in total darkness
- ullet Jonah reminds us of many other Bible characters $\,{}^\sim$ ending like Nebuchadnezzar

God preserved Jonah's life / but in a dark, damp, smelly dungeon of a fish...

It was not God that held him there / It was his own pride / For 3 long days & nights

Jonah was blessed greatly by this / God put him in a head lock / Jonah tapped out

Are you prideful? Are you withholding yourself from God.. fighting against Him?

Humble yourself before God's might / Embrace His forgiveness / Serve Him gladly
