Jonah 3.4-10 (read chapter 3)

"Nineveh Repents"

Sep 22nd, 2013

Recap

- <u>Jonah disobeyed God</u> and ran away towards Tarshish
- God went after Jonah for his own good, because He loved him
- The sailors demonstrated more <u>fear of God</u> & <u>respect for life</u> than did Jonah
- They <u>reluctantly sacrifice</u> Jonah & are amazed at <u>great fish</u> & sudden <u>calm</u>
- God <u>preserved</u> Jonah in the fish ~ then <u>saved</u> him from it in **2.10** (*spoke*)
- Jonah is given a 2nd chance ~ "the message that I tell you" ~ he obeys

Message Proclaimed & Believed

- We finally hear the prophetic message God has for Nineveh
 - o v4b ~ "Yet 40 days , and Nineveh shall be overthrown"
 - o Jonah's message spread fast ~ "Jonah began to enter the city on the 1st day"
- v5 ~ Repentance & revival begins with people & spreads to the king (v6)
 - o **v6** ~ The king dons <u>sackcloth</u> and <u>sits in ashes</u>
 - o **v7** ~ He proclaims a total fast (food or drink) for all living (men & animals)
 - **v8** ~ They are to abandon sinful ways and call upon God
 - o **v9** ~ They do this in the hopes that God will relent

God Relents

- v10 ~ "Then God saw their works .. God relented from the disaster .."
 - o "Does God relenting mean that He did not fulfill His Word?"
- There was no caveat placed in the prophecy of destruction (reread v4b)
 - Yet God's Word states this ~ "The instant I speak concerning a nation and concerning a kingdom, to pluck up, to pull down, and to destroy it, 8 if that nation against whom I have spoken turns from its evil, I will relent of the disaster that I thought to bring upon it .." (Jer 18.7-8)
 - o God reserves the right to relent on all prophecies of destruction
 - David interceding for his first son w/Bathsheba was based upon this
- Jesus regarded their repentance as true (Mat 12.41 ~ ".. will rise up .."

God is merciful .. He extends grace and mercy even to these evil Assyrians

No one <u>deserves</u> God's mercy ~ God extends mercy to whomever He wishes

But we know this table represents <u>mercy & grace</u>, <u>forgiveness & acceptance</u>
