Communion Meditation – The Suffering Servant

Isaiah 53.4 Afflicted August 28th, 2011

Similarity of vss 3 and 4

- Read 3b and 4a&b ~ "sorrows" & "grief"
- Read 3d and 4c&d ~ "esteem"
- Emphasis of **v3** was we despised Him
- Emphasis in v4 is that God afflicted Him

v4a ~ "He has borne <u>our griefs</u>" and "carried <u>our sorrows</u>"

- The grief and sorrow of **v3** were Christ's
- But the grief and sorrow of v4 is <u>ours</u>

v4c ~ "Yet we esteemed Him stricken" and "afflicted by God"

- Though He bore our griefs and carried our sorrows
- We regarded Him as deserving what He got

"He must have done something"

- In John 9.1-3 w/man born blind ~ "Rabbi. who sinned, this man or his parents?"
 We assume justice is at work when evil befalls people
- <u>Ill</u>: <u>The Profiler</u> ~ Victims differ in "<u>deserving</u>" what they got
 - o Good samaritans vs. criminals betrayed by an accomplice
- <u>III</u>: <u>Amistad</u> excerpt ~ Cinque and Yamba c/Bible pictures
 - "these people suffered" ~ "baby born and everything changed"
 - "He was killed" ~ "He must have done something" ~ "What have we done?"

But what about the children?

- <u>Ill</u>: <u>City Cop</u> ~ "coping mechanism they deserved it"
 - $\circ~$ But the heinous death of children is different
 - III: TV show about death of boy Adam in welfare home
- <u>Tower of Siloam</u> story **Lk 13.1-5** ~ emphasize **v5** at end though . . .

In this world the innocent sometimes suffer . . . Jesus's death exemplified this . . .
