Psalm 37.34 Good Waiters June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012

## Servants are "Waiters"

- v34a ~ "Wait on the Lord" ~ "Doesn't that make us all <u>waiters</u>?"
  - Servants are expected to wait ~ And they're to wait <u>respectfully</u>...
  - We <u>say</u> we're servants of God on the earth . . . But <u>are we good waiters</u>?
- v34b ~ "and keep His way"
  - A good waiter "lives to serve" ~ "Your wish is my command!"
- If you're a <u>bad waiter</u> then you're probably a <u>bad servant</u> . . .

## **Exalted and Exultant**

- v34c ~ "He shall exalt you to inherit the land"
  - We that wait upon the Lord shall be rewarded for our service
    - <u>Good service</u> is <u>expected</u> at a restaurant
    - You may generously tip good service ~ but bad service sticks out
- v34d ~ "you shall see . . . the wicked cut off"
  - This allows us opportunity to exult . . . We are made to love justice
  - Those who've suffered injustice ~ shall see justice prevail . . .

Though we are God's servants ~ <u>at this table we are served</u> Just as <u>Jesus served</u> His apostles at the Passover meal ~ <u>He serves us</u> And we must wait ~ wait to be served by the Lord
