Communion Meditation Psalm 16.8 ~ Past, Present and Future

"I have set the LORD always before me; Because He is at my right hand I shall not be moved."

Study / meditation method: "Rolling Emphasis"

- Emphasize each word while walking through sentence
- This forces you to think how each word interacts with others

Psalm 16.8a emphasized

"I" ~ personal responsibility / the youngest communicant here is to do this
"have" ~ past tense / already taken care of
"set" ~ active / not passive / we are each accountable to God for this
"the LORD" ~ no substitutes or idols / God alone should fill our vision
"always" ~ persistence / perseverence / constancy
"before me" ~ in his path / filling his vision

Psalm 16.8b emphasized

"Because" ~ cause and effect / placed here (not in middle) to emphasize
"He is" ~ present tense / constant presence
"at my right hand" ~ position of trust and reliability / dependence
<u>///</u>: Lee said of Jackson "He has lost his left arm, but I have lost my right"
"I shall not" ~ future tense / confident asurance
"be moved" ~ David is committed to following God / like "Shekinah glory"

Focus in verse upon time and tense

- past ~ our steadfast service ~ I "have set"
- present ~ God's presence with us ~ "He is a my right hand" / "Where is God?"
- future ~ confidence ~ "I shall not be moved"

Focus in Lord's Table upon time and tense

- past ~ Christ's service ~ 1 Cor 15.3 ".. Christ died for our sins .."
- present ~ Christ's presence ~ 2 Cor 5.17 ".. if .. is in Christ, he's a new creation .."
- future ~ always ~ 1 The 4.17 ".. thus we shall always be with the Lord."
