2 Peter 3.1-7 The Greater Unconformity June 8th, 2014

v6 ~ ".. the world that then existed perished .."

- Been listening to a tape series on Creation this past week
 - o Dr. Henry Morris on the rationality of the creationist perspective
 - o Dr. Duane Gish on poverty of fossil record and human evolution hoaxes
 - o Dr. Steve Austin on the Mt. St. Helen's eruption in May 1980
 - o <u>Dr. John Morris</u> on the <u>global flood</u> and massive rock formations in US
- Uniformitarianism vs. catastrophism (continuity vs. discontinuity)
- The Bible teaches catastrophism without apology (Genesis 5 through 9)
 - o Scientific evidence supports catastrophism as well
 - o Search for Noah's Ark ~ "What would it prove if discovered?"

Judgmentalism of Noah and Jesus ~ (redirected)

- People <u>choose</u> not to believe the truth ~ despite overwhelming evidence
- Heb 11.7 ~ "By faith Noah .. prepared an ark .. by which he condemned the world"
 - Noah's actions were perceived as judgmental ~ so are ours
- Jesus responded to accusations of being judgmental ~ "How?"
 - o Read John 12.46-48 ~ "... the word that I have spoken will judge him .."
- Read Gen 7.11 ~ "in the <u>second</u> month, the <u>seventeenth day</u> of the month"
- Luke 17.26 ~ "as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man: They <u>ate</u>, they <u>drank</u>, they <u>married</u> wives, they were given in marriage, until <u>the day</u> that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all."

Uniformitarian Assumptions

- Humans assume everything remains the same from day to day
- Is 56.12 ~ " .. Tomorrow will be as today, and much more abundant .."
- The <u>flood was condemnation</u> of God ~ The <u>ark was salvation</u> of God
- God's <u>justice</u> fell upon the earth but in <u>mercy</u> He rescued the righteous

We live in uniformitarian times ~ spend, spend, spend (no worries ..) But our God is not a uniformitarian .. He specializes in discontinuity .. We praise God for this because we are saved by it ..!
