Communion Meditation – In the Wilderness

Exodus 15.22-27

Free to Obey

August 31st, 2014

v22 ~ No Drinking Water

- 3 days into the wilderness / "found no water"
 - They are <u>thirsty</u> and they are <u>searching</u>
 - Until then water hadn't been a problem
- Imagine joy & relief when water found at Marah
 - But their joy is crushed / the water is too bitter to drink
 - o Thirsty people will drink anything / this must have been horrible

v24 ~ Murmuring and Prayer

- They murmur, "What shall we drink?"
 - o "What does Moses do?" / Prays to God
- The people had a sense of entitlement
 - Moses had a sense of <u>helplessness</u> & <u>dependence</u>
 - o The people should have felt helpless too . . .
 - o But instead they felt righteous indignation / blamed Moses
- God answers Moses prayer / water made "sweet"

v25 ~ People Tested

- The people were <u>tested</u> / Did they <u>pass or fail?</u>
 - They <u>failed</u> this test and many more besides . . .
- God <u>rewarded</u> them with water but threatened <u>penalties</u>
- Then He takes them to <u>Elim</u>
 - o There they had plentiful water and rest in the shade of trees
 - o God had this waiting for them all along

When our needs / wants aren't met we can become <u>bitter</u>
This stems from a sense of <u>entitlement</u>
We must embrace our <u>dependence</u> on God
