Numbers 14.36-38 Contrasting Leaders January 11th, 2015

Story of Spies

- Read Num 13.1-2 ~ God commands spies be sent out
- Read Num 13.27-28a ~ "Thus they .. fortified and very large"
- Read Num 13.30-31 ~ Caleb & Joshua advise to go / 10 others not to go
 Judah and Ephraim represented by Caleb and Joshua
- > Num 14.1-4 ~ People want to appoint leader and return to Egypt
- Read Num 14.5-10 ~ People resist Moses, Aaron, Joshua and Caleb
- > Num 14.11-19 ~ Moses intercedes for the rebels
- Read Num 14.20-23 ~ God pardons / Pronounces consequence of unbelief
- Read Num 14.29-32 ~ All over 20 to die in wilderness
- **Read Num 14.36-38** ~ Ten spies lacking faith die in plague

Contrasts in Leadership

- <u>Courage</u> of Joshua and Caleb (Num 13.30)
- Humility of Moses, Aaron, Caleb and Joshua (Num 14.5-6)
- Faith of same group of men (Num 14.9b)
- <u>Selflessness</u> & <u>Wisdom</u> of Moses exhibited (Num 14.11-19)
 - $\circ~$ By contrast the other 10 lacked courage and faith
 - They twisted the truth and enflamed discontent

Good and Bad Leaders

- All twelve spies were leaders (Num 13.2-3)
 - $\circ~$ But 10 of them were not very good leaders
- Moses was a great leader ~ He was from the tribe of Levi
- Caleb and Joshua were good leaders ~ They were from Judah and Ephraim
- The tribes of Judah and Ephraim became powerful in their new homeland
- And the Levitical priesthood was powerful throughout their history

Leaders must not be <u>foolhardy</u> / But they must be <u>courageous</u> Sadly, many people are in leadership that ought not be Many in leadership do not lead, they just <u>follow from the front</u>
