Communion Meditation – In the Wilderness

Numbers 16.1-40 God's Gracious Plans February 8th, 2015

Popularly Known as Korah's Rebellion

- Korah, Dathan & Abiram & 250 Leaders Rebel
- Moses commanded them to gather before the Lord (v16)
- Korah <u>obeyed</u> the command & brought 250 w/censers (v17-19)
- Dathan and Abiram did not / they <u>stayed</u> at their <u>tents</u> (v25)
- Dathan and Abiram & <u>entire families</u> stood at door of tents (v27)
- The <u>earth swallows</u> them plus Korah (**v31-33**)
- And <u>fire</u> fell upon the 250 men with censers (**v35**)

"Who was Swallowed Up?"

- Dathan and Abiram's families perished / "What about Korah's?"
- Read Num 26.9-11 (Second Census) / "the children of Korah did not die"
- So Dathan and Abiram's family lines ended that day (Reubenites)
- But Moses is clear that only Korah perished with them / not his children

Who were the Korah, Dathan and Abiram?

- Korah was a Levite / Dathan and Abiram were Reubenites
 - o Korah was a descendant of Kohath a son of Levi
 - The <u>Kohathites</u> were <u>carriers</u> of the contents of the tabernacle
 - The process is described in **Num 4.1-20** (Read Num 4.15-20)
 - Korah came to <u>resent</u> his duty as if he were a <u>beast of burden</u>
- In **1 Chr 6** we learn the prophet Samuel was a Levite / a descendant of Korah
 - Look at inspired intros to **Psalms 44 49** ("sons of Korah")

Duty & Obedience

- Korah was accustomed to obeying Moses and the Priests
- Though rebelling he obeyed Moses' instructions / Dathan & Abiram did not
- Korah's family was spared death / but Dathan & Abiram's families died too

God's grace covered Korah's family even amidst his rebellion God's plan extended to 7+ generations of Korah's children God's grace lessens the extent and severity of our sinfulness
