Colossians 1.27-29

"Christ in Us"

Our Relationship to Christ (Read Col 1.19-29)

- vss 19-23 ~ "Christ in Place of Us"
- vss 24-26 ~ "Us in Place of Christ"
- Today's message is "Christ in Us"

The Analogy of Marriage

- In Eph 5.32 Paul wrote of "two becoming one" as a "great mystery"
 - This "mystery" came to mind as he wrote of marriage
 - o But this mystery concerned "Christ and the church"

v27 ~ "God willed to make known .. the riches of the glory of this mystery"

- This "mystery .. is Christ in you, the hope of glory"
- This mystery refers to a truth God had hidden until now
 - \circ That truth was the <u>gospel</u> / an enduring bond between God and man
 - People thought of God as entirely "other" / no longer that simple
- It is <u>only this</u> that <u>gives us</u> a basis for <u>hope</u>

v28 ~ "preach .. warning .. teaching . present" \rightarrow "every man"

- <u>Hope</u> for <u>unbelievers</u> comes in <u>many forms</u> / it's placed in <u>many things</u>
 Relationships, philosophies, education, jobs, progress, experiences
- But the <u>believer</u> can take <u>little comfort</u> in all of these
 - The <u>believer knows</u> hope must rest in <u>God alone</u>
 - $\circ~$ All other repositories of hope will fail us / temporally and eternally
- Only perfection is acceptable to God / Perfection comes only through Christ

v29 ~ "labor .. striving . mightily"

- Paul gave <u>all</u> of his <u>life</u> and <u>strength</u> to building, strengthening the church
 - Planning, re-planning, coordination, public evangelism
 - Preaching, personal ministry, letter writing
 - Traveling, hardships and persecution
- Yet it was God working mightily in and through Paul

God worked in and through Paul / God works in and through us All of God's striving leads to perfection, leads to Christ's victory in us and through us
