Colossians 2.6-10 (**read 1-10**)

## Colossians 2

- **Col 1** ended emphasizing Christ's substitutionary role
- Col 2 emphasizes the centrality of Christ to our new life
  - Vss 1 thru 5 were about Christ as our Treasure
  - Today's message is about building upon the reality of being in Christ

## **Building Upon Being "in" Christ**

- v6 ~ ".. have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him"
  - "have received" ~ We're in Christ We've received Him already
  - "so walk in Him" ~ Embrace the opportunity we have in Him
- v7 ~ ".. rooted and built up in Him, .."
  - <u>III</u>: <u>Planting in mulch</u> ~ Plant life cannot be sustained
  - What are you rooted in?
    - <u>Shallow</u> rocky soil (*self-centered, feel good*) ~ joy, feelings, no depth
    - <u>Hard</u> soil (not even trying) ~ No church, no Bible, only words
    - <u>Weedy</u> soil (*want world and Christ*) ~ Loves the world too much
    - But a Christian's <u>only</u> soil is Christ

## Philosophy of Men and Empty Deceit

- v8 ~ "Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit"
  - o iaw/ "tradition of men", "basic principles of the world"
    - It's always been done this way / polygamy of kings in OT
  - $\circ~$  "empty deceit" ~ Con Job / Victim promised much, but left with nothing
- I like "Austrian economics", "libertarian principles"
  - $\circ~$  Principles not grown in soil of Christ, but in a worldly hybrid

## In Him Dwells .. and .. You are In Him

- All <u>real</u> value of this world is embodied in Christ and His promises
- There is a lot of <u>fool's gold</u> to tempt us away from what is real
- We're asked to trade away what we have for what's behind another door
  - But there's nothing of greater value on this earth

We're in Christ / We're a new creation / Our allegiance differs from others Christ is our Savior, our Master, our Lord / We'll only be satisfied in Him
