Lev 16.1-10, 20-22 Two Goats October 8th, 2017

v7 ~ "take the two goats and present them"

- v8 ~ "Aaron shall cast lots"
- **v9** ~ "offer it as a sin offering"
- v10 ~ "presented live .. let it go"

Biblical Words in Popular Culture

- "by the skin of my teeth" ~ Job 19.20
- "house divided against itself" ~ Mt 12.25 (Lincoln)
- "drop in the bucket" ~ Isaiah 40.15
- "to everything there is a season" ~ Ecc 3.1 (song)
- "scapegoat" ~ Lev 16.8

Sacrificial Goat

- v15 ~ "kill the goat of the sin offering"
- Aaron went behind the veil 3 times on the Day of Atonement
 - o Incense / blood of bull / blood of goat

Scapegoat

- v20 ~ "bring the live goat"
- v21 ~ "lay both his hands on the head"
 - o "confess over it .. sent it away"
- scapegoat ~ def ~ "someone blamed for something others complicit in"
 - Did the scapegoat bearing this guilt really "get away"?
- Both goats suffer
 - First dies immediately / Other is abandoned
 - 2nd dies from starvation, wild animals, exposure, etc...

Jesus bore penalty for sin –AND– the guilt of sin

Jesus bore penalty of both goats / died for sins and experienced rejection

He bore our sins –AND– the guilt of our sin

Read Hebrews 10.19-22 ~ "Therefore .. pure water"
