Ruth 4.13-22 Series: Ruth "Dynastic Planning" June 24, 2018

v13 ~ "The Lord gave her conception"

- Nowhere is the line between "faith" and "science" stronger than here
 - Science says God has <u>no role</u> to play in conception
 - Yet our text clearly states that God "gave her conception"
 - Gen 29.31 ~ "When the Lord saw that Leah was unloved He opened her womb"
 - Sarah (Abimelech), Rebekah, Rachel, Hannah (Samuel), Samson's mother, Elizabeth
- Unbelievers have excuse for lack of faith / Not so w/believers

v14 ~ "Then the women said to <u>Naomi</u>"

- "The Lord .. has not left you without a kinsman-redeemer"
 The women congratulate Naomi / Not just Ruth
- v17 ~ "There is a son born to Naomi"
 - $\circ~$ They even refer to the son as Naomi's / She nurses him

Read vss18-21 ~ Genealogy of David

- Who wrote the Book of Ruth? / Prophet Samuel near end of life
- Who was Perez? / Son of Judah and Tamar brother Zerah with red thread
 Tamar was wife to Judah's two sons (Er and Onan) but not Shelah
- Who was Salmon? / Obed's father (married Rahab harlot) Mt 1.5
- Who was Moab? / Son of Lot born to his eldest daughter Gen 19.37
- Yet God chose to establish kingdom of Israel/Judah through this line

Dynastic Planning

- Boaz and Ruth lived during the <u>time of the judges</u>
 - During that time "everyone did what was right in his own eyes"
 - Yet Boaz and Ruth chose to follow God's Law
- Later Israel wanted a king and Saul was chosen (based on height)
 - $\circ~$ Yet God chose a king (from line of Boaz and Ruth) based on obedience

The story of Ruth demonstrates that: <u>obedience leads to life</u> That though our "sins are like scarlet, they shall be white as snow" That dynasties are founded on seemingly small acts of obedience
