Zeph 1.1-9, 2.1-3 "Resist Superstitions" November 25th, 2018

What? - v2-3 ~ "I will utterly consume everything from the face of the land"

- Not a summary of Zephaniah / Judgment promised for Judah around 640BC
- Life became more & more difficult / Decades passed but judgment came

Why? - v4-9 ~ "I will cut off every trace of Baal .. but also (syncretism) .."

- "Why is God sending judgment?"
 - o **v4-5** ~ The people worship idols, heavens, swear to Jehovah and others
 - **v6** ~ No longer serve or seek Jehovah
 - v9 ~ "I will punish all those who leap over the threshold"

Popular Superstitions

- Friday the 13th / Itchy palms (right \$ in, left \$ out scratch to undo it)
- Walking under a ladder (disturbing spirits place thumbs at fingers juncture)
- Breaking mirrors (7 years bad luck bury during full moon)
- Horseshoes (right-side up pick up w/right hand spit on it throw over left)
- Spilled salt (throw a pinch over left shoulder to ward off spirits attracted by it)
- <u>black cats</u> (witches kept them shape shifters Napoleon / Hitler)
- sneezing ("God bless you Gazuntheit" ward off black plague in 1665)

"What was with leaping over the threshold?"

- Read 1 Sam 5.1-5 ~ ".. the Philistines took the ark .. to this day."
- God was not pleased with people honoring that event in this way
- God deposed Dagon / Not stepping on threshold was to honor Dagon

"Why are People Superstitious?"

- It explains why bad things sometimes happen to them
- It gives them an illusion of control over difficult aspects of life
- It's easy to scoff at some superstitions But, do we ignore our own?
- If we miss devotions are we quick to believe anything bad is God's rebuke?

Our God is One – Yet He is also 3 Persons / Superstitions <u>depersonalize</u> God Pray to God when tempted by superstitious thoughts
