- I. The Lions in Daniel's Den. Daniel faced three types of lions: Satan, physical lions and the Lion of the Tribe of Judah.
 - A. (The lion, Satan) The Mystery of the Offence
 - 1. Why he should have been liked
 - a) Daniel was needed
